

Azerbaijan - Netherlands relations

Brief historical information on diplomatic relations:

Kingdom of the Netherlands recognized the independence of Azerbaijan in December 31, 1991. Diplomatic relations between the two countries were established in April 1, 1992.

In May 2007, Republic of Azerbaijan has established its Embassy in Netherlands and in October 2009 the Netherlands has established its Embassy in Azerbaijan.

Currently the Ambassador of Azerbaijan to the Netherlands is H.E.Mr. Mir-Hamza Efendiyev and H.E.Mr. Aryen Peter Uytendillen is the Ambassador of the Netherlands in Azerbaijan.
