

Azerbaijan - Sweden relations

Brief information on diplomatic relations:

Sweden recognized the independence of Azerbaijan on January 16, 1992. The diplomatic relationships between Sweden and Azerbaijan were established on May 8, 1992.

Sweden opened its honor consulate in Baku in February 1998. The honorary consul of Sweden to Azerbaijan is Mr. Eldar Ismailov. Azerbaijan opened its Embassy in Sweden in January 2008. Ambassador of Azerbaijan to Sweden is Mr. Adish Mammadov. Swedish ambassador to Azerbaijan with the residence in Stockholm is Mr. Michael Ericsson.
