

The relations between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Cuba

Brief information on diplomatic relations:

The diplomatic relations between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Cuba were established on March 27, 1992. The diplomatic mission of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Havana was opened in 2007 and the Embassy of the Republic of Cuba to Azerbaijan was opened in 2008. The Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Azerbaijan Yashar Aliyev is concurrently accredited to Cuba.

High-level visits and meetings:

Ministers of Foreign Affairs:

On September 19, 2005, in the framework of the 60th session of the UN General Assembly the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Elmar Mammadyarov met with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Cuba Fernando Rog.

On September 28-30, 2006, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Elmar Mammadyarov paid an official visit to the Republic of Cuba.

On February 18, 2011, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Cuba Bruno Rodriguez Parilla paid an official visit to the Republic of Azerbaijan.

Inter-parliamentary relations:

There is Azerbaijan-Cuba interparliamentary working group acting within Milli Majlis (parliament) of the Republic of Azerbaijan

There is Cuba-Azerbaijan interparliamentary working group acting within National Assembly (parliament) of the Republic of Cuba. The head of group is Elbys Perez Olivera.

Treaty-legal basis:

Eight documents have been signed between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Cuba.
