

Azerbaijan - Macedonia relations

Brief information on diplomatic relations:

The Republic of Macedonia recognized Azerbaijan's independence on June 25, 1995 and two countries established diplomatic relations on June 28, 1995.

Faig Baghirov, the Ambassador of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the Republic of Macedonia with residence in Ankara presented his credentials to the President of the Republic of Macedonia on September 28, 2011.

Goran Taskovski, the Ambassador of the Republic of Macedonia to Azerbaijan with residence in Ankara presented his credentials to the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan on April 18, 2013.
