

The relations between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the United Mexican States

The diplomatic relations between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the United Mexican States were established on February 10, 1992. The Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the United Mexican States was opened on January 10, 2008 and the Embassy of the United Mexican States to the Republic of Azerbaijan was opened on October 1, 2014.

High-level visits and meetings: **Ministers of Foreign Affairs:**

On September 26, 2008, in the framework of the 68th session of the UN General Assembly the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Elmar Mammadyarov met with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the United Mexican States Patrisia Espinosa Kanteyano.

On September 21, 2010, in the framework of the 64th session of the UN General Assembly the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Elmar Mammadyarov met with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the United Mexican States Patrisia Espinosa Kanteyano.

On March 27-29, 2011, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Elmar Mammadyarov paid an official visit to the United Mexican States;

On February, 2012, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Elmar Mammadyarov paid working visit to the United Mexican States.

Inter-parliamentary relations:

There is Azerbaijan-Mexico interparliamentary working group acting within Milli Majlis (parliament) of the Republic of Azerbaijan

On April 8, 2010, Mexico-Azerbaijan interparliamentary friendship group was established in the Chamber of Deputies of the Mexican Congress. The group is heading by Raymundo King de la Rosa;

On November 4, 2011, “Point of agreement by the Foreign Relations Committee on Asia-Pacific Ocean Region of Senate on conflict in the Nagorno Karabakh region” was adopted in Mexican Senate;

On December 8, 2011, “Point of agreement on Armenian-Azerbaijan Nagorno Karabakh conflict” was adopted in the Chamber of Deputies of the Mexican Congress.

On July 17-20, 2012, the President of Chamber of Deputies of the Mexican Senate Oscar Martin and members of Mexico-Azerbaijan interparliamentary friendship group visited Azerbaijan.

Treaty-legal basis:

Five document have been signed between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the United Mexican States
